PaWaPi Waterfront Supervisor

General Function: Under the supervision of the PaWaPi Camp Director, incumbent will be responsible for the safe and organized operation of all aquatic activities at camp.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Serve as the authority on safety at the waterfront, working closely with staff to ensure safety standards and procedures are understood and always maintained by all camp staff and campers.
- 2. Properly instruct all campers and staff on safety standards and procedures for all waterfront operations.
- 3. Understand camp emergency policies and procedures on waterfront operations.
- 4. Oversee swim testing for all campers to make sure that campers participate in activities according to their swimming abilities.
- 5. Maintain a positive attitude and act in a professional manner when interacting with members, program participants and other staff.
- 6. Help develop program activities and teach/engage children regarding safety in and around the water.
- 7. Other duties as assigned.

Salary/Hours: \$14-\$15 per/hour; 40 hrs. per week (Monday-Friday) beginning late May through August

Job Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent is required. Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Current and valid lifeguard certification.
- CPR and First Aid certified prior to the beginning of camp (the Y will pay for this training)
- Currently hold or attain a fishing license.
- Strong background working as a lifeguard. Experience leading and teaching water safety preferred.
- Prefer at least 2 years experience of working with children.
- Ability to respond to safety and emergency situations.
- Must complete all required YMCA trainings in the expected timeframe.

Benefits:

- A 50% discount on child care (not camp) at one of the Lansing YMCA's centers! (Subject to availability)

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is often required to: bend, stoop, kneel, twist, reach with hands, sit, stand for an extended period, lift and/or move up to 40 pounds, have finger dexterity, grasp, perform repetitive motions, speak, hear and have visual acuity.
